








Curtis Robert Frilot

Nov. 30, 1936 - Dec. 19, 2021

Curtis Robert Frilot, most recently from Lake Havasu City, Arizona, passed away unexpectedly on December 19, 2021 at the young age of 85.

Born November 30, 1936 to Alton Joseph Frilot and Beatrice Mary Gomez Vincent in Los Angeles, California, Curt was a fourth generation Californian. Curt was raised by his stepfather Andrew Vincent and Bea Vincent and early on lived with his half-sisters, Celeste Vincent and Charlotte Vincent.

Curt was a devout Catholic. He married the love of his life, Loretta Eugenia Cozzini in 1958 and immediately started their family of three beautiful daughters, and one amazing son. Curt loved God, family, Country, and tequila.

Curt honorably served his Country in the United States Army from 1955 through 1957, stationed in Germany. Curt loved sports and helped coach and mentor his kids' baseball and softball teams for many years. He was an avid California Angels baseball fan and Rams football fan while living in Anaheim for over 25 years.

He loved to boat and took numerous family beach camping trips, yearly, to the Colorado River where family enjoyed water sports and sleeping outdoors, counting the stars. When sand in the crack got old, he switched it up for houseboating Lake Powell. If he wasn't in his boat, Curt was likely dirt-bike riding in the desert with his son and friends.

After moving to Arizona from California in 1992, he became a member of Havasu4Wheelers Jeep Club and experienced remarkable countryside throughout the entire Western U.S. with his co-pilot Loretta by his side. Amazing stories and pictures always followed. He served as club president and also wrote the monthly newsletter.

Curt was an Electrical Drafting Engineer by trade for the aeronautics industry. He was also the founder and owner of Sportsman's Spirits Liquor store in Anaheim, California; proud to sell "the coldest beer in town". He loved to shoot the breeze with anyone and everyone.

He was a staunch conservative, believed in the core principles and values that this great Country was founded upon, didn't care about being politically correct, and spoke his mind on important matters. If there wasn't a sporting event blaring on the TV, you'd probably find him searching for an old John Wayne or Clint Eastwood movie, or getting a daily dose of Rush Limbaugh. Curt also had a culinary love for garlic and spicy foods.

Curt is survived by his loving family; wife Loretta Frilot, daughter Lisa Mohan (James), daughter Jeannette Shade, son Daniel Frilot (Parvaneh), daughter Michelle Anglin (Ronald), nine grandchildren, four great grandchildren, half-sister Charlotte (David), nieces and nephews. He is resting in Heaven reunited with family and friends that have passed before him and now shooting the breeze with grandson, James. He will be loved and missed forever by all those left behind.

A Funeral Mass will be held at Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church, (AZ) in the coming weeks.

Curt will rest in peace at Riverside National Cemetery (CA) along with his fellow military veterans at a later date. In lieu of flowers, donations can be made to Veterans Crisis Line.

- HAVASU 4 WHEELERS TRAIL RATINGS -- Mandatory Vehicle Equipment - All vehicles on H4W runs must be 4-wheel drive & equipped with a CB radio, fire extinguisher, first aid kit, tow straps, and front and rear tow hooks or safe hitching point all in working order. RATING **DESCRIPTION** 1 EASIEST: Passable by stock vehicles. Gentle fairly wide grades. EASY: Use of 2 wheel and some 4-wheel drive. Trail may have some rocks, loose road surface, and ruts but a reasonable line for driving. 2 3 EASIEST MODERATE: 4-wheel drive with aggressive tire treads. Expect a rough road with rocks and sand that requires lower tire pressure. Substantial sections of single lane. 31/4 MODERATE: Some 4 wheel driving experience needed. Same as above with some use of high and low range gearing. These trails have a rough, rutted surface, rocks and deep sand. Sections may be steep enough to cause traction problems, narrow shelf roads with steep drop -offs and tight clearance between rocks. 31/2 HARDER MODERATE: For experienced drivers. At least a 2" lift and 33' tires with aggressive tire tread, one locked differential, high and low range gearing. Potentially dangerous, large rocks, ruts, steep slopes, loose surface and narrow clearances that need to be negotiated. 33/4 HARDEST MODERATE: Skilled experienced drivers only. DIFFICULT: Highly skilled experienced drivers only. Same as above with belly up, 4 to 1 transfer case or equivalent, skid plates, beefed up 4 axles and suspension system. Probable strapping/winching. Vehicle width and wheelbase should be considered. Possible body damage. HARD: All of the above. Probable body damage.
