6 Jeeps and 9 Wheelers.

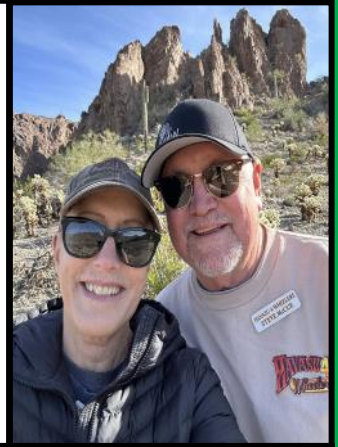

- HAVASU 4 WHEELERS TRAIL RATINGS -

- Mandatory Vehicle Equipment - All vehicles on H4W runs must be 4-wheel drive & equipped with a CB radio, fire extinguisher, first aid kit, tow straps, and front and rear tow hooks or safe hitching point all in working order.

RATING	DESCRIPTION
1	EASIEST: Passable by stock vehicles. Gentle fairly wide grades.
2	EASY: Use of 2 wheel and some 4-wheel drive. Trail may have some rocks, loose road surface, and ruts but a reasonable line for driving.
3	EASIEST MODERATE: 4-wheel drive with aggressive tire treads. Expect a rough road with rocks and sand that requires lower tire pressure. Substantial sections of single lane.
3¼	MODERATE: Some 4 wheel driving experience needed. Same as above with some use of high and low range gearing. These trails have a rough, rutted surface, rocks and deep sand. Sections may be steep enough to cause traction problems, narrow shelf roads with steep drop-offs and tight clearance between rocks.
3½	HARDER MODERATE: For experienced drivers. At least a 2" lift and 33' tires with aggressive tire tread, one locked differential, high and low range gearing. Potentially dangerous, large rocks, ruts, steep slopes, loose surface and narrow clearances that need to be negotiated.
3¾	HARDEST MODERATE: Skilled experienced drivers only. Same as above with both differentials locked, some strapping/winchng. Very challenging sections, extremely steep grades, loose surfaces, large rocks, deep ruts and tight clearances.
4	DIFFICULT: Highly skilled experienced drivers only. Same as above with belly up, 4 to 1 transfer case or equivalent, skid plates, beefed up axles and suspension system. Probable strapping/winchng. Vehicle width and wheelbase should be considered. Possible body damage.
5	HARD: All of the above. Probable body damage.

THE HISTORY OF THE NELLIE E SALOON

The Nellie E Saloon (Desert Bar) is situated in the Buckskin Mountains, on land that was an old mining camp. The camp was located on the portion of land that is now the parking lot. When Ken acquired the land in 1975, there was nothing left of the mining camp. With the land and a liquor license from an old business on leased river land, Ken decided to give the bar in the desert idea a try. In 1983, Ken opened for business in the temporary three-sided structure which is across from the restrooms. He operated there for the next five years, until the current saloon was constructed. The name, Nellie E, originates from the old mining claim. They used to mine copper, and then take it to the smelter and get gold.

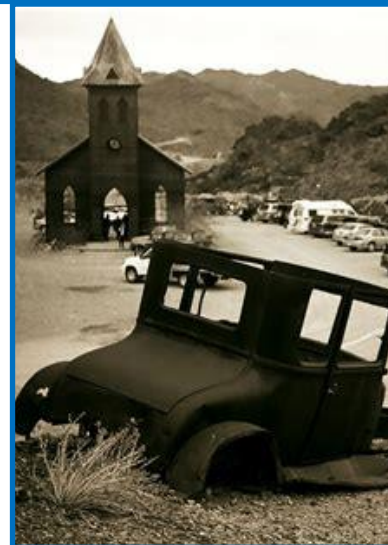
When Ken opened the bar he hauled water in a 50-gallon tank loaded on the back of his truck. Then he purchased an old fire truck which he used to haul water. In 1989, he started using a well in the canyon as his water source. In the summer of 1997, Ken drilled a new well on the North side of the saloon that operates on solar power, with the pump set at 360 feet. The fire truck in the parking lot was acquired from Scott Winter in March of 2001. The fire truck was used by Scott's father during the development of Blue Water Lagoon.

The Nellie E was completed in 1988. The inside of the saloon is unique in many ways, it has windows that are old glass refrigerator doors, the bar stools are made of steel and sway from side to side. The top of the bar is brass, and the ceiling is made of stamped tin purchased from a factory in Missouri. The saloon is powered by solar, stored in batteries and run through inverters.

The bridge was the next big project built in 1991 and dedicated in October of the same year. The church was started in 1993, completed in 1996, and dedicated in October 1996. The church is made of solid steel and the walls and ceiling are made of the same stamped tin used in the saloon.

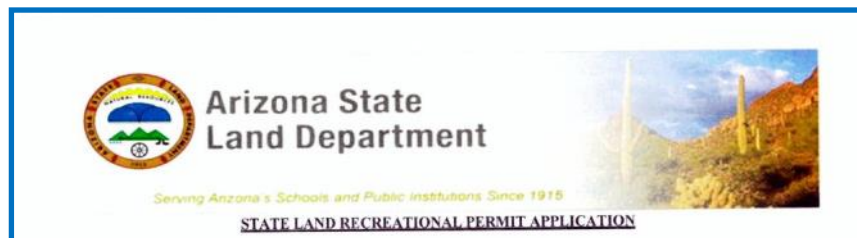
People who buy a **BLACK 4x4** are business minded and conservative with little time for fun. But then again they can be the exact opposite.

Now you can go to "Recreational Permit - Arizona State Land Department" online to complete and pay for the permit, and then print it. No more printing off a form and sending it in and then wait for the permit to arrive in the mail. Start the New Year out right by having a current permit. To submit on line go to "land.az.gov", click on "APPLICATIONS AND PERMITS", then "Online Recreational Permit Portal here". Read the instructions, pay, and submit, your new form will be emailed to you and you're good for a year.

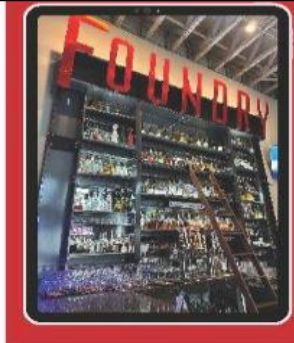

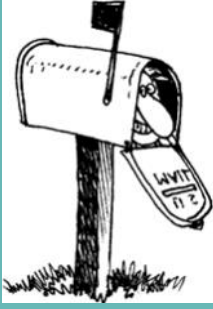
